This job aid provides information on how to clear cache files or temporary internet browser history on local machines using Google Chrome.



- 2. On the navigation bar at the top-right of Chrome page, click the icon.




3. Select the **Settings** link.

Select **Privacy and security** on the left pane then click on **Clear browsing data** on the right side as shown above.


4. On the screen that is now open, click the **Advanced** tab. Then in the **Time range** drop-down, select **All time** from the drop-down as shown above

Select ALL checkboxes shown above.

Scroll down to make sure all remaining checkboxes are checked.

5. Click the Clear Data button.



6. Click the **X** in the upper right hand corner to close the Chrome browser and **close all other open**Chrome sessions and try accessing the intended URL once more.
